

Instructions for assembling your pilot's licence:

Style A (folded): Using card stock print this image on both sides of the paper (when turning the paper in the printer for printing side two, turn from top to bottom so that the appropriate information is backed up on side 1). Then using a sharp knife and a straight edge, make straight cuts in the order as numbered EXCEPT FOR LINE 2 WHICH WILL BE A FOLD LINE (score with a none-working ballpoint pen for easier folding).

1 — CUT

2 — FOLD for folded licence (Style A)

SUPERCAR PILOTS LICENCE

SUPERCAR COCKPIT DRILL AND TAKE-OFF PROCEDURE

Before take-off the following procedure must be closely followed:

1. Check all switches in the "off" position.
2. Check fuel gauges for the amount of fuel in all tanks.
3. Check all other instruments, Oxygen, Clearance, Temperature, and set all controls in the neutral position.
4. To start port engine, switch to "charge" and wait for revolution counter to reach 15,000 rpm. Before switching to "fire", Repeat for starboard engine. (It is possible to "charge and fire" both engines together but only in an emergency), but everything is clear of Supercar before selecting vertical take-off. (Full boost on take-off is only necessary when fully loaded).
5. Select vertical take-off, open throttles, and when clear of any obstruction, change to horizontal flight.

Style B (wallet): Print only one side of card stock. With a sharp blade and straight edge make the seven straight cuts in numbered order. You will now have 4 separate pieces. Place the pieces in your "wallet" (see HOW TO MAKE YOUR OWN PLASTIC LICENCE WALLET) with side "A" backed with "B", and side "C" backed with "D".
